

General Guidelines for De-Code Paper

De-Code Online entrance exam comprises 2 parts, A and B.

Part A: General Ability Test (GAT) – 60 minutes

Part B: Creative Ability Test (CAT) – 120 minutes

Aspirants who clear these tests are shortlisted to appear for the Personal Interview round.

There will be no negative marking for a wrong answer and the language of the written test will be English. No entries will be accepted after the exam duration.

Candidates need to clear the exam if they want to secure admission in Bachelor of Design programs offered at Code, VGU Jaipur. Code offers B.Des programs in the following specializations:

1. Fashion Design
2. Interior Design
3. Lifestyle Accessory Design
4. Visual Communication Design

General Ability Test (GAT) – Max Marks: 40

This test comprises of the below mentioned sections with **10 questions** in each section.:

- Quantitative Ability
- Communication Ability
- Analytical Ability
- General Knowledge

All the questions will be in MCQ Format i.e. Multiple Choice Questions with 4 options against each question will be provided and the candidate has to choose the correct answer.

Creative Ability Test (GAT)

This test is to judge the skill, power of observation in concept development and design ability of the candidate. An important aspect of the test is the creative & innovative use of colors & sketching skills. The duration of CAT is 120 minutes with 5 questions to be submitted. Some questions will have choices so the candidate can choose amongst those questions.

Once the candidate has submitted the GAT paper in 60 minutes, he/ she can start with CAT paper.

All the answers to the questions in CAT will be in the form of any composition like a poster, an illustration or a sketch which is to be drawn on a **white A4 paper**. The candidate needs to click the picture and then upload it on the link of the site which will be provided to him/her.
